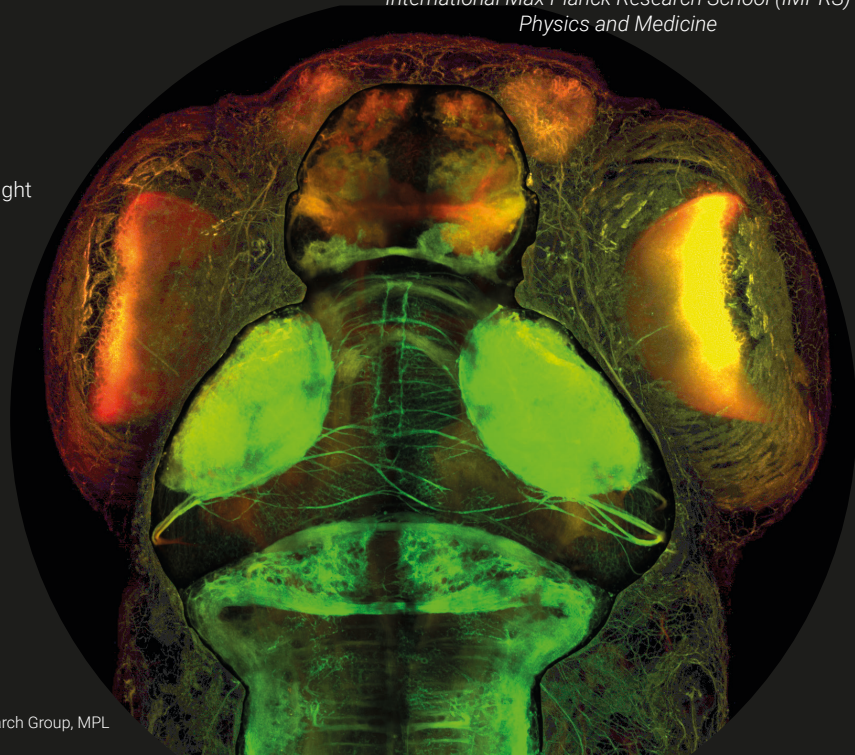

In becoming a mentor you

- get insight information into the problems and questions of the younger generation
- get the possibility to strengthen your network and the one of your mentored master student

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Structure of the mentoring program:

- Duration 12 months
- 3 obligatory meetings; if more are necessary, they can be executed flexibly on a voluntary basis
  - 1<sup>st</sup> month: “get-to-know” meeting
  - 5<sup>th</sup> month: “timeline” meeting

The student is expected to draft a study plan to structure his/her master and discuss it in detail with the mentor.

- 12<sup>th</sup> month: “outlook” meeting

A last meeting to wrap up, adjust the study plan and talk about future possibilities and perspectives.

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
